OTI Annotation:	This clone was engineered to express the complete ORF with an expression tag. Expression varies depending on the nature of the gene.
Components:	The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).
Reconstitution Me	<ul> <li>thod: 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.</li> <li>2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.</li> <li>3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.</li> <li>4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid at the bottom.</li> <li>5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of shipping when stored at -20°C.</li> </ul>

### CRIGENE Androgen Receptor (AR) (NM\_001011645) Human Tagged Lenti ORF Clone – RC215709L1

# Gene Summary:The androgen receptor gene is more than 90 kb long and codes for a protein that has 3 major<br/>functional domains: the N-terminal domain, DNA-binding domain, and androgen-binding<br/>domain. The protein functions as a steroid-hormone activated transcription factor. Upon<br/>binding the hormone ligand, the receptor dissociates from accessory proteins, translocates<br/>into the nucleus, dimerizes, and then stimulates transcription of androgen responsive genes.<br/>This gene contains 2 polymorphic trinucleotide repeat segments that encode polyglutamine<br/>and polyglycine tracts in the N-terminal transactivation domain of its protein. Expansion of<br/>the polyglutamine tract from the normal 9-34 repeats to the pathogenic 38-62 repeats causes<br/>spinal bulbar muscular atrophy (SBMA, also known as Kennedy's disease). Mutations in this<br/>gene are also associated with complete androgen insensitivity (CAIS). Alternative splicing<br/>results in multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms.
