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Gene Summary:This gene is a member of the MAGEA gene family. The members of this family encode<br/>proteins with 50 to 80% sequence identity to each other. The promoters and first exons of the<br/>MAGEA genes show considerable variability, suggesting that the existence of this gene family<br/>enables the same function to be expressed under different transcriptional controls. The<br/>MAGEA genes are clustered at chromosomal location Xq28. They have been implicated in<br/>some hereditary disorders, such as dyskeratosis congenita. Several variants encoding the<br/>same protein have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Aug 2020]

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
