Background: This gene encodes 3-hydroxyacyl-CoA dehydrogenase type II, a member of the short-chain

dehydrogenase/reductase superfamily. The gene product is a mitochondrial protein that catalyzes the oxidation of a wide variety of fatty acids, alcohols, and steroids. The protein has been implicated in the development of Alzheimer's disease, and mutations in the gene are the cause of 2-methyl-3-hydroxybutyryl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MHBD). Several alternatively spliced transcript variants have been identified, but the full-length nature of only two transcript variants has been determined.








HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY HSD17B10 ([RC201734], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-HSD17B10. Positive lysates [LY401426] (100ug) and [LC401426] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-HSD17B10 monoclonal antibody.






