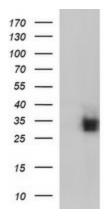




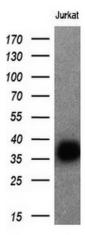

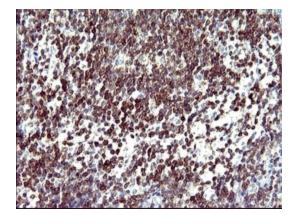

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CD7 (Cat# [RC201231], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CD7(Cat# TA506337). Positive lysates [LY416844] (100ug) and [LC416844] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Western blot analysis of extracts (10ug) from 1 cell line by using anti-CD7 monoclonal antibody (1:200).
