






HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY ANKRD49 (Cat# [RC204657], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-ANKRD49(Cat# [TA507228]). Positive lysates [LY413612] (100ug) and [LC413612] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.


